Job Purpose:

We are looking for experienced Youth Workers to help support our Holiday Club offer. Delivery of exceptional youth work will be 100% of your job role. Future Youth Zone will run Junior holiday club sessions on every day of most school holidays from 8am to 6pm. Fixed term contracts will be available and generally, we will ask you to commit to 1 week as a minimum.





Arts, along with Sport and Youth Work is at the heart of Future's offer to young people. The Arts offering at Future is wide ranging and as a member of the Arts team, you will be key in ensuring young people have access to an exciting and engaging programme of multi-disciplinary activities that will be challenging, stimulating, fun, engaging and developmental. You will have access to our brand-new facilities, equipped with all of the equipment you could possibly want or need. You will be involved in teaching the fundamentals of your area of the Arts, in line with your skills, as well as facilitating taster sessions and competitions to engage young people and build their skills.

Within the Arts Team, we are looking for talented artists in Music, arts and crafts, Drama, Dance and all performing arts. Ideally, you will have experience, or one or more arts qualifications at Level 2.

Holiday Club Selection

Fix term, weekly contracts are available for each school holiday week. You will accrue annual leave during the fixed term contract and days taken must be agreed prior to the start of the contract. Holiday that is not taken during the contract term will be paid.

Prior to your weeks session, you will need to commit to 3 hours evening or weekend training for safeguarding, Database, telephone and general duty training.

Context of the post:

Barking and Dagenham Youth Zone, named "Future" by local young people will be the first Youth Zone in London opened by the national charity, OnSide. Opening to young people in Spring 2019 and opening for our first Holiday Club in the Spring Half Term holidays.

Future, like all OnSide Youth Zones, exists to give all give young people, particularly those who are disadvantaged, somewhere to go, something to do and someone to talk to. Each Youth Zone is, open 7 days a week, at weekends and for Holiday Club, which runs from 8am





to 6pm on most school holiday days. The Youth Zone's purpose is to help young people grow to be happy, healthy and successful adults.

Future's state-of-the-art £6.5 million building on Parsloes Park and will provide young people with access to a range of activities, offering them the opportunity to try new things, meet new friends and gain support from friendly, warm and positive staff and volunteers. To access a Youth Zone, young people aged 8 - 19 (or 25 with additional needs), simply pay 50p per visit and £5 per year membership.

Sessional Youth Worker Duties and Responsibilities - General

- Be a role model for young people and present a positive "can do" attitude
- Take personal responsibility for own actions
- Commit to a culture of continuous improvement
- Work within the performance framework of Future Youth Zone and OnSide
- Represent Future Youth Zone positively and effectively in all dealings with internal colleagues, and external partners
- Comply with all policies and procedures, with particular reference to safeguarding, codes of conduct health and safety and equality and diversity to ensure all activities are accessible
- Represent Future Youth Zone positively and effectively in all dealings with internal colleagues, and external partners
- To be alert to issues of safeguarding and child protection, ensuring the welfare and safety of Youth Zone members is promoted and safeguarded, and to report any child protection concerns to the designated Child Protection Officers using the safeguarding policies, procedures and practice (training to be provided)
- To assist with any promotional activities and visits that take place at the Youth Zone
- To actively promote the Youth Zone and positively contribute towards increasing Youth Zone membership
- To adhere to The Future Youth Zone policies at all times, with particular reference to Health and Safety, Safeguarding and Equal Opportunities

- Work with the management team to develop a programme that is exciting, challenging and ever-changing within your area
- To deliver activities to young people within your area
- To listen to young people and create a seasonal programme that means their wants and needs
- The role is 100% face to face delivery with young people
- To work directly with young people to develop their social skills and encourage them to use their talents and reach their goals





- To directly deliver a high-quality programme of activities that is exciting, safe, varied, innovative, developmental and directly responds to the diverse needs, concerns and interests of our members
- Introduce young people to new experiences within your area
- To have great energy to establish positive relationships with young people and the wider youth work team and visitors to Future Youth Zone
- To work flexibly to ensure the needs of the members who are disadvantaged, discriminated against or who have disabilities or additional needs
- To ensure that the members maintain a high standard of behaviour and discipline during sessions by making the area a hub of activity and fun
- To ensure the participation of young people in activities and ensure that their ideas contribute fully to the delivery of activities
- To assist with any promotional activities and visits that take place at Future Youth Zone
- To actively promote Future Youth Zone and positively contribute towards increasing Youth Zone membership
- To promote and safeguard the welfare of young people at all times
- To be able to think on your feet and deliver an activity with minimal equipment
- Ability to enthuse others including staff, volunteers and young people
- To make the environment fun and the place young people want to be
- To be an active member of the team and operate in line with the values and principles of Future Youth Zone
- Carry out any other reasonable duties as requested by management

An Enhanced BDS is required for this position and will be arranged by Future Youth Zone with your permission should the job role be offered to you.
