

## JOB PURPOSE:

To diligently clean Future youth zone and ensure the building is maintained to the highest cleanliness standards for staff and young people alike. To work as a team and support colleagues. To help to cover holidays and sickness absence as and when required, as well as committing to 3 afternoon shifts per week, as detailed above. To take pleasure in ensuring we provide a safe and clean environment for the young people that will shape the future of Barking and Dagenham.



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Future was the first Youth Zone in London opened by the national charity, OnSide in Spring 2019. Future, like all OnSide Youth Zones, exists to give young people, particularly those who are disadvantaged, somewhere to go, something to do and someone to talk to. Each Youth Zone is open 7 days a week, at weekends and during school holidays, with the purpose of supporting young people to become happy, healthy and successful adults.

The Youth Zone supports young people like Monique, Owen and Bola to grow and develop.

## DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES



- To be responsible for cleaning areas of Future Youth Zone as allocated by the Facilities Officer or other appropriate manager
- To perform various cleaning activities including cleaning toilets, sanitary fittings and surrounds; spot cleaning of spillages; wiping furniture, ledges, pipes, paintwork, doors and polishing door and balcony glass; emptying and cleaning bins; mopping and spray cleaning hard floor surfaces, including using floor cleaning equipment such as a Karcher; floor polishing; wiping, polishing and straightening furniture; replenishing supplies in toilets; and moving items of furniture and equipment
- To operate cleaning machinery for cleaning soft and hard surfaces, such as vacuum cleaners and polishers
- > To follow building opening and closing procedures
- To report any emergency maintenance problems, including toilets and other water fixtures, or hazards immediately to the Facilities Officer or other appropriate manager
- > Carry out any other reasonable duties as requested by management
- > Be a role model for young people and present a positive "can do" attitude.
- > Take personal responsibility for own actions.
- > Commit to a culture of continuous improvement.
- > Work within the performance framework of Future Youth Zone and OnSide.
- Represent Future Youth Zone positively and effectively in all dealings with internal colleagues, and external partners.
- To be alert to issues of safeguarding and child protection, ensuring the welfare and safety of Youth Zone members is promoted and safeguarded, and to report any child protection concerns to the designated Child Protection Officers using the safeguarding policies, procedures and practice (training to be provided).
- > To assist with any promotional activities and visits that take place at the Youth Zone.
- To adhere to Future Youth Zone policies at all times, with particular reference to Health and Safety, Safeguarding and Equal Opportunities
